

Josh Lynn picked to head Bronco football next season

The 'Lynn Dynasty' continues for NMMI football, as Josh Lynn becomes the just the 30th head Bronco football coach since the program's inception 112 years ago under William Fitzgerald, back in 1898. Former head coach Jeff Lynn, Josh's older brother, will be leaving the Institute to start a new NAIA program at Wayland Baptist University.



Josh Lynn began his collegiate playing career at Eastern New Mexico University, where he earned 1st Team All-Lone Star Conference honors as a tight-end during both his junior and senior seasons. After completing his Bachelor's degree at ENMU, he continued to be a part of Greyhound football by working as a student assistant while getting his Master's degree. In 2003, coach Lynn moved to Cleveland, Mississippi, to become the defensive secondary coach for Delta State University. In 2005, when Jeff Lynn got tapped for the head Bronco football position, Josh was hired and came to NMMI to coach the defensive backs and special teams. He's been coaching Bronco football since then, and has served in both the offensive and defensive coordinator roles.
